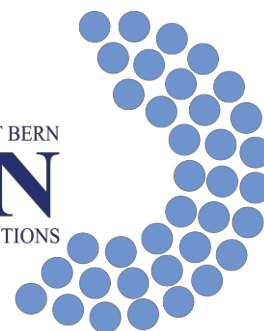

General Conditions

A. Requirements for participating in a MUN Conference:

- 1) MUN Membership: Members with active membership status can attend our training events and conferences with MUN University of Bern. Members with passive membership status can only attend our training events. Membership status may only be granted after the membership fee is received by MUN University of Bern.
Exception I: Seminar participants are not obliged to be an active or passive member of MUN University of Bern in order to attend our training events or Conferences.
Exception II: Members of another MUN association affiliated with JUNES, who are participating in a joint delegation with MUN University of Bern, are not obliged to be an active or passive member of MUN University of Bern as well.
- 2) MUN Registration: MUN University of Bern requires the definitive confirmation of the registration *at least* three days before the official deadlines. The official and internal deadlines are on the “Conference Registration” form.
- 3) MUN Costs: MUN University of Bern prepares their members for a successful experience at a MUN Conference. However no general and direct financial aid (in form of direct payments or sponsoring) to participants is provided. Delegates have to cover their own costs arising from the participation at a MUN Conference.
- 4) Single Delegation: If a member wants to attend a MUN Conference on her/his own, she/he is responsible for organizing the travel and accommodation on her/his own. MUN University of Bern will do its best to support her/him, when she/he asks for help. However MUN University of Bern is not liable for any inconveniences.

B. Code of Conduct for MUN Conferences

Our Delegates represent MUN University of Bern and thereby our reputation. Their behavior has to be tailored to this accountability. Any form of disrespectful behavior towards people or material, alcohol abuse or further actions of misconduct are not tolerated.

- 1) Behavior at the Conference: While participating at a MUN Conference, delegates have the responsibility to always maintain the highest level of professionalism and diplomacy. Conference staff, advisors, and fellow delegates are treated with the highest level of courtesy and respect. Furthermore Delegates conduct themselves in accordance with the applicable law and the respective code of conduct of the respective conference venue.
- 2) Behavior outside the Conference: MUN University of Bern members are asked to show responsibility, especially when it comes to alcohol consumption. Excessive alcoholization is to be avoided. Delegates who do not follow these restrictions may be barred from MUN University of Bern.
- 3) MUN University of Bern declines any responsibility for its members’ behavior. Each delegate is responsible for his or her own individual actions and neither the Team nor its Executive Board, will take over any kind of liability.
- 4) Breaches of the Code of Conduct of MUN University of Bern will be discussed by the Executive Board and may lead to the exclusion of delegations or the association.

By joining the association, you agree to MUN University of Bern photographing you and using photographs containing your appearance for their own purpose only, website, social media etc., in accordance with Swiss Private Law.
